1. Definition of the **Hakka Dialect** It seems simple to say that the **Hakka dialect** is the **dialect** spoken by the **Hakka** people, identified as originating in northern China and moving to southern China through five waves of migration over the last 1,500 years (Luo 1933). **Hakka** has been recognized as a modern Chinese **dialect** group (Yün et al. 1989; Würm and Li 1987). This story is, however, problematic in several respects. Recent studies suggest that the name **Hakka** (Cantonese *haak3gaag* 客家 'guest families'; Mandarin *kèjíā*) arose as a product of the dispute between Cantonese-speaking n...
