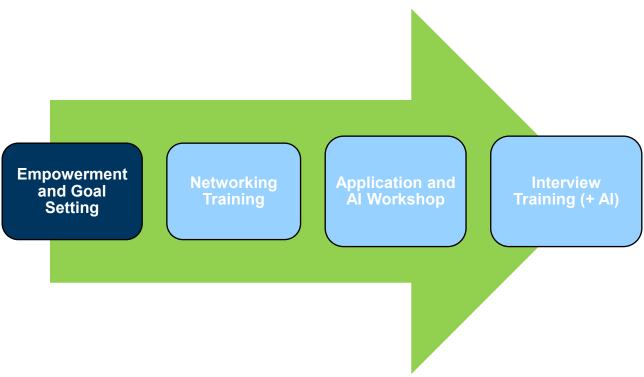

- Salary and salary development
- Job security
- → (rather) intrinsic motivation

Focus: Recreation and Individual Growth

- Work/Life balance
- Free time planning
- Family planning
- Residence planning
- Material needs
- Prestige
- → (rather) extrinsic motivation

Strategic positioning on the German job market

Seven ingredients for a successful career start

1. Strategic linking of resources and goals

- → Identify strenghts and unique selling points
- → Identify and address structural deficits (e.g. through job advertisements)

2. Practical experience

- → Internships
- → Working student positions
- → cooperative these
- → Freelancing
- → Voluntary work
- → Part-time jobs to finance your studies

3. A relatively quick course of study

- → Grades are (mostly) a subordinate criterion in Germany
- → Thematic adaptation of studies to professional goal

4. Networking

- → Continuous development of online and offline networks
- Use first and second-order networks

5. Application skills
