GENERAL INFORMATION

The student council is the association of all students and doctoral candidates ¹ in physics. All students and doctoral students of the Faculty of Physics are thus members of the student council and enjoy the right to speak, propose and vote at the plenary assembly (PA), as well as the right to vote and stand for election.

CANDIDATURES

If interested, every member of the student council can run for office, in particular² in person at a meeting of the student representatives or at the PA or in text form, i.e. informally by email to fs-rat@physik.rub.de. In addition to the name, it is useful to provide contact information (e-mail address, mobile phone number, etc.).

This applies to both the student representatives and the faculty council.

AGENDA

In principle, the agenda can only be supplemented by items that have been received by the student representatives at least four days before the PA. Requests for agenda items shall be published at least two days before the PA.

DOCUMENTS

The student council of physics and astronomy will present its rules of procedure (GO) as well as the budget to the PA. The current version of the GO can be found on the website of the student council [1]. For the budget, please refer to the PA.
